
Dear Saraland Residents:

Our City is pleased to provide garbage/trash service to you at a reasonable cost. Our current vendor, AmWaste, provides curbside collection carts to contain all your household garbage. The **garbage** is collected **twice** a week. Carts should be placed at the roadside by **7a.m.** the morning of your designated collection days to ensure service. Your basic service allows for **one cart-full** of household garbage per pickup.

Once a week, AmWaste also provides **trash** collection of up to **FOUR CUBIC YARDS** of bulky waste and yard debris. Limbs and branches may not exceed **6 feet** in length and **6 inches** in diameter. All leaves must be bagged. We would also remind you that **CONTRACTORS** providing yard care/debris removal services or remodeling are **responsible** for properly disposing of limbs and construction debris. **AmWaste does not pick up televisions, tires, or commercial debris brought to the residence. Please call AmWaste for proper disposal of these items.** If you suspect someone of dumping, please contact our Inspections Department at 679-5502. Our goal is to keep our neighborhoods looking as nice as possible. Large amounts of trash left in front of residences distract from this and create a health hazard. If you have a need for more than the allocated trash pickup during a given week, we would ask that you call **AmWaste** at (251) 227-8220 and they will provide the cost of having the additional trash removed. You can then remit payment for this service directly to AmWaste.

**If our garbage/trash vendor should miss a pickup or If you have not signed up for garbage service, please contact AmWaste at [customer@amwaste.net](mailto:customer@amwaste.net) or (251) 227-8220. All Saraland residents are required to participate in this service per Alabama Code Section 22-27-3 and Saraland Ordinance Section 12-33. The only exceptions for non-participation are if your house is under construction or if the water service is discontinued. If you have any additional questions or unanswered concerns, please contact my executive assistant, Paige, at (251) 675-5103, and she and I will work together to resolve them.**

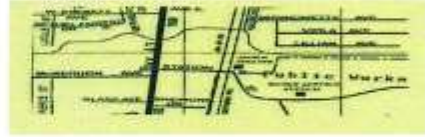

**RE: CLEANUP DAY April 6, 2019  
BEGINNING AT 8 AM AND ENDING 12 PM  
150 STATION STREET at the Public Works Facility**

One of Saraland's goals is to beautify our community. With the **Spring** cleanup season having arrived, the City of Saraland is giving its citizens an opportunity to dispose of unwanted items on Saturday, **April 6, 2019** from **8 AM to 12 PM**. This activity is being co-sponsored by Keep Saraland Beautiful.

**You can bring the following items to the clean up area:**

- TV's (No TV's larger than 59 inches)
  - Old ink cartridges
  - Cell phones
  - Cameras
  - Computers
  - Tires (\$2.00 per tire disposal fee / rim must be removed from tire) **LIMIT 6**
  - Normal household waste and yard waste. Bulky items like sofas, chairs, tables, dryers, stoves, etc.
- Batteries
  - Paint cans (**Limit 10**)
  - Oil
  - Antifreeze

**We can't accept:**

- Refrigerators/freezers/air conditions, unless the Freon has been removed and tagged
- Mineral spirits
- Propane/welding tanks
- Pesticides or lawn treatment chemicals
- Hazardous or medical waste

The city has also arranged for the **Shred It** Company to be onsite for complimentary disposal of sensitive or private paper. This is limited to **2 banker boxes** per vehicle.

This program is for Saraland residents only. Identification will be required. I hope you will take advantage of this opportunity. If you have any questions, please call Paige at 675-5103.
