Said temporary decorations and signs shall be kept in good condition and shall be permitted for no more than thirty (30) days.

Examples of permitted temporary sign types:

<u>Banner:</u> Any sign of lightweight fabric or similar material that is mounted to a pole or a building at one or more edges.

***Temporary promotional banners cannot exceed 30 SF; banners for grand openings/conventions cannot exceed 50 SF. Permits for temporary promotional banners may only be issued twice within a six (6) month period.

Bunting: A lightweight loosely woven fabric used typically for flags and festival decorations.

<u>Feather Flag:</u> A portable vertical type banner attached to a flexible pole. These flags are available in various shapes and sizes.

Pennant: Triangular shaped flag. May also refer to a streamer with multiple pennants adjoined one to another.

<u>Streamer:</u> Any long narrow wavy strip allowed to float or wave in the wind. Typically bright or metallic color in order to attract attention.

<u>Yard Sign:</u> Non-permanent type signs usually used for advertisement and information purposes. They are lightweight, yet strong enough to withstand most weather conditions.

- *All other signs requested to be permitted shall be subject to review and approval by the Building Official or their designee.
- *Fees: \$10.00 for temporary banners and other temporary type signs, not including yard signs. \$1.00 per temporary yard sign (a maximum of 2 are permitted per street frontage).
