Councilmember Cromer was absent.

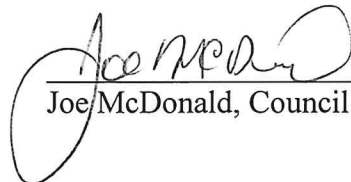
Councilmember Biggs opened the meeting with prayer.

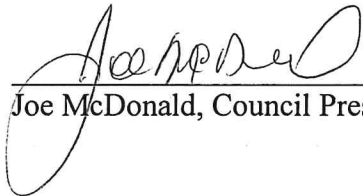
Council President McDonald advised he anticipates the executive session to last approximately thirty (30) minutes.
