City Attorney Andy Rutens was present.


The Council discussed agenda items and general municipal business.

The Council adjourned into executive session with the Mayor and City Attorney at 7:02 p.m.


Motion was made by Councilmember Biggs, seconded by Councilmember Moye, to reconvene

at 7:23 p.m. with all members present. Motion carried.


Motion was made by Councilmember Moye to adjourn.
