



DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE

The population in the City of Saraland, AL was 16,171 per 2020 Census data – which is more than the projected growth in this graph.

The region has a civilian labor force of 6,649 with a participation rate of 62.2%. Of individuals 25 to 64 in the City of Saraland, AL, 21.6% have a bachelor's degree or higher which compares with 33.5% in the nation.

The median household income in the City of Saraland, AL is \$61,116 and the median house value is \$159,000.



EMPLOYMENT TRENDS

As of 2021Q2, total employment for the City of Saraland, AL was 6,984 (based on a four-quarter moving average). Over the year ending 2021Q2, employment increased 6.0% in the region.





WAGE TRENDS

The average worker in the City of Saraland, AL earned annual wages of \$49,597 as of 2021Q2. Average annual wages per worker increased 6.1% in the region over the preceding four quarters. For comparison purposes, annual average wages were \$64,141 in the nation as of 2021Q2.



Annual average wages per worker data are derived from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and imputed where necessary. Data are updated through 2021Q1 with preliminary estimates updated to 2021Q2.







COST OF LIVING INDEX


The Cost of Living Index estimates the relative price levels for consumer goods and services. When applied to wages and salaries, the result is a measure of relative purchasing power. The cost of living is 11.8% lower in City of Saraland, AL than the U.S. average.





Employment by occupation data are estimates are as of 2021Q2. Education levels of occupations are based on BLS assignments of 2021Q2. Forecast employment growth uses national projections from the Bureau of Labor Statistics adapted for regional growth patterns.

EDUCATION LEVELS

Expected growth rates for occupations vary by the education and training required. While all employment in the City of Saraland, AL is projected to contract 0.2% over the next ten years, occupations typically requiring a postgraduate degree are expected to grow 0.3% per year, those requiring a bachelor's degree are forecast to grow 0.1% per year, and occupations typically needing a 2-year degree or certificate are expected to grow 0.0% per year.


Traffic Counter Sites Throughout The State, With Data Available From 2014 - 2020.





Saraland School District Has A Graduation Of 94, Placing It In The Top 30% Of The Alabama School Districts.






SARALAND: TRADE AREAS & DRIVE TIMES FOR WALMART AND PUBLIX




5-10-15-minute drive times from the Saraland Walmart (1095 Industrial Parkway)


5-10-15-minute drive times from the Saraland Publix (21 Shell St.)



SARALAND WALMART – TOTAL WEEKLY & MONTHLY VISITORS








SARALAND WALMART – VISITOR RANKING COMPARISON: U.S., ALABAMA & LOCAL STORES


SARALAND WALMART – VISITOR LOCATION PRIOR & POST VISIT WALMART






SARALAND PUBLIX – VISITOR RANKING COMPARISON: U.S., ALABAMA & LOCAL STORES



Saraland Publix Percentile Ranking Compared To Other Alabama Publix Stores For Number Of Visits.




Saraland Publix visitor rankings compared to national, Alabama, and local (within 50 miles) Publix stores.
