

The Saraland City Council met in special session on April 5, 2024 at the Saraland Municipal Annex. The meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m. by Council President McDonald. Roll call was as follows:

Motion was made by Councilmember Cromer, seconded by Councilmember Moyer, to approve a change order request not to exceed \$36,000.00 for expediated preparation and shipping of an electrical transfer switch. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilmember Cromer, seconded by Councilmember Moyer to approve the change in payment methodology, concerning the sales and use tax waiver for the sportsplex contract with White-Spinner Construction. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilmember Cromer, seconded by Councilmember Moyer to approve the change in formula for calculating rain days for the sportsplex contract with White-Spinner Construction. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilmember Cromer, seconded by Councilmember Hudson to approve the preliminary contract with PCDA Architecture to prepare the conceptual drawing for the relocation of city hall services to the Alorica Building in the amount of \$16,680.00. Motion carried.


Danielle Dials with Fox10 News presented information regarding the proposed Class Act Award.
