

The Saraland City Council met in special session on April 22, 2024, at the Saraland Municipal Annex. The meeting was called to order at 6:21 p.m. by Council President McDonald. Roll call was as follows:

Councilmember Moyer opened the meeting with prayer.

Council President McDonald advised the purpose of this meeting is to discuss White-Spunner's Sportsplex bid and performance.

Motion was made by Councilmember Cromer, seconded by Councilmember Moyer, to partner with the Saraland Board of Education, 50/50, and enter a ten (10) month contract for the Fox10 Class Act Program for \$4,300.00 per month beginning in August 2024. Motion carried.

Council President McDonald advised he anticipates the executive session to last approximately 30 minutes.


The Council adjourned into executive session with the Mayor and City Attorney at 6:23 p.m.


Motion was made by Councilmember Cromer, seconded by Councilmember Biggs, to reconvene at 6:59 with all members present. Motion carried.
