

The Saraland City Council met in special session on July 8, 2024, at the Saraland Civic Center due to air conditioning issues at the Saraland Municipal Annex. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Council President McDonald. Roll call was as follows:

Attorney Andy Rutens was present.

Councilmember Biggs opened the meeting with prayer.

Council President McDonald advised the purpose of this meeting is to consider lighting proposals for the Sportsplex.

Other municipal business may be considered at this time.

Motion was made by Councilmember Moye, seconded by Councilmember Biggs, to authorize the Mayor to enter into a lighting agreement with Musco Lighting, for lighting at the Sportsplex in the amount of \$1,849,000.00, contingent upon the City receiving written confirmation that Hellas Construction will not be providing lighting pursuant to their contract with the City for providing lighting. Motion carried.


Motion was made by Councilmember Hudson, seconded by Councilmember Moye, to authorize the Mayor to approve Restoration 1 to begin clean up and repairs at the Alorica building. The quote received from Restoration 1 was in the amount of \$49,431.13 and will be paid from the insurance claim for the vandalism which occurred April 22, 2024. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilmember Biggs, seconded by Councilmember Moye, to approve payment to Southern Labor & Contracting for invoice # 1674 to replace the roof at the Saraland Library in the amount of \$47,826.00. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Council, motion was made by Councilmember Moye to adjourn at 6:45 p.m.
